I. DEFINITIONS

The parties referred to in this Agreement shall be defined as follows:

- A. Company, Us, We: The Company, as the creator, operator, and publisher of the Digital Platforms, makes the Digital Platforms available to users. III. Log Data

When you access or use our Digital Platforms, we may automatically collect certain information sent by your browser or device (“**Log Data**”). Log Data may include information such as your Internet Protocol (“IP”) address, browser type, browser version, the pages of our Digital Platforms that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, and other diagnostic or usage information.

IV. Cookies

Our Digital Platforms may use cookies and similar technologies to collect information and improve your experience. Cookies are small data files that may include an anonymous unique identifier and may be stored on your device when you visit a website.

You may configure your browser to refuse certain cookies or to notify you when a cookie is being sent. However, disabling cookies may affect the availability or functionality of certain portions of our Digital Platforms.

V. Security

The security of your Personal Information is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.
